HUB certification is defined by the State of Texas. Certifications from the following agencies are accepted by the district: State of Texas Historically Underutilized Business Program, Dallas/FortWorth Minority Supplier Development Council and the North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency.

- Points are awarded in the RFQ evaluation processes for architects and construction frms for having a local presence (defined asTarrant County) and for the percentage of HUB participation committed.
 - HUB participation for architects is scored based on the percentage of each project the architect commits will be performed by HUB sub-consultants (e.g., civil, structural and MEP engineers landscape architects acoustic consultants; etc.).
 - HUB participation for construction frms is scored based on the percentage of each project the construction frm commits will be performed by HUB sub-contractors.
- In the RFQ process for construction frms, frms are also scored on their approach in recruiting, mentoring and obtaining HUB participation.
- HUB participation is encouraged; however, lack of HUB certification does not preclude a frm from participating in the district's contracting and purchasing activities.
