Any person who knowingly falsifies information on a form required for enrollment of a student in a school district commits an offense under Section 37.10 of the Penal Code, which offense is a Class A misdemeanor unless the person's intent is to defraud or harm another, in which event the offense is a felony of the third degree. Further, such person is liable to the district to the district if the student is not eligible for enrollment in the district but is enrolled on the basis of the false information. The person is liable, for the period during which the ineligible student is enrolled, for the greater of: (1) maximum tuition fee the district may charge under 25.038, Texas Education Code; or (2) the amount the district has budgeted for each student as maintenance and operation expenses. A Class A misdemeanor is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00, a confinement in a jail for a term not to exceed on year, or both such fine and imprisonment. A third degree felony is punishable by a prison sentence for a term of not more than ten years or less than two years, and additionally, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00.
